

THE HOLY GOSPEL FOR THE THIRD SUNDAY OF THE YEAR, YEAR B: 21ST JANUARY

A reading from the holy Gospel according to Mark 1:14-20

After John had been arrested, Jesus went into Galilee. There he proclaimed the Good News from God. 'The time has come,' he said, 'and the kingdom of God is close at hand. Repent, and believe the Good News.'

As he was walking along by the Sea of Galilee he saw Simon and his brother Andrew casting a net in the lake – for they were fishermen. And Jesus said to them, 'Follow me, and I will make you into fishers of men.' And at once they left their nets and followed him.
